## ACCORD KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

### TERRI CLARK

Terri has been in the field of health education and training for nearly 30 years, and currently is the Prevention Services Coordinator at Action Wellness. Throughout her career in public health, she has been an advocate for LGBT equality and sexual health across the life cycle. She has extensive experience in the field of sexuality education and training, including HIV prevention, sexual expression and aging, and LGBT topics, and is currently working on a number of projects to advance the field of sexuality and aging.



Terri is a certified trainer with SAGE (Services and Advocacy for LGBT Elders).

### RABBI ERICA STEELMAN

Rabbi Erica Steelman, MAHL, MPP, is Staff Chaplain and Director of LGBT+ Initiatives at Abramson Senior Care. She provides spiritual care to members of the Abramson Senior Care community including both long-term and short-term care residents, family members, staff, and volunteers. In 2014, Rabbi Erica spearheaded and continues to lead what is now called Abramson Senior Care's LGBT+ Initiatives.



Rabbi Erica also serves on several LGBT elder care advisory committees including the LGBT Elder Advisory Committee to the Philadelphia Mayor's Office of LGBTQ Affairs and the LEI (Long-Term Care Equality Index) Advisory Council.

### DR. RACHEL LEVINE

Dr. Levine is currently the Secretary of Health for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and Professor of Pediatrics and Psychiatry at the Penn State College of Medicine. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Society for Adolescent Health and Medicine, and the Academy for Eating Disorders. She also is a board member of ASTHO, the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials.



Dr. Levine joined the Wolf administration in January 2015 as the Physician General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and served from 2015-2017. She was named Acting Secretary of Health in July 2017 and confirmed as Secretary of Health in March 2018.

In addition to her recent posts Dr. Levine is also an accomplished regional and international speaker, and author on the opioid crisis, medical marijuana, adolescent medicine, eating disorders, and LGBT medicine.
